Question One: Expanding Slot Machine Gaming


If approved, would allow a second slots parlor to exist in Massachusetts. The 2011 gambling law currently allows for up to three resort casinos and one slots parlor. The slots parlor license is owned by Penn National Gaming, which operates Plainridge Park Casino in Plainville.

Question Two: Charter School Expansion

If approved, would let state education officials approve up to 12 new charter schools a year as long as the enrollment didn't exceed more than one percent of traditional public school enrollment.

Question Three: Conditions for Farm Animals

If approved, would phase out what advocates say are "extreme" methods of farm animal confinement so that animals could turn around, extend their limbs or lie down in their pen.
